## **Technical Sergeant Jeremy E. Sandlin Jr**

Technical Sergeant Jeremy Sandlin is currently an Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies and the Training Instructor for Air Force ROTC Detachment 915 at West Virginia University.

TSgt Sandlin's career began in February 2013 when he enlisted in the Air Force as an Airman First Class. Upon graduation from basic training, TSgt Sandlin attended the Fuels Technical Training School at Sheppard AFB, TX. He graduated from the course in July, 2013.

From July 2013 to January 2017, A1C Sandlin was assigned to the 319<sup>th</sup> Logistics Readiness Squadron, Grand Forks AFB, ND. While at Grand Forks AFB, A1C Sandlin served as a Fuels Distribution Operator and Fuels Fixed Facilities Technician, delivering fuel to the RQ-4 Global Hawk, enabling Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance missions over the US-Canadian border.

From January 2017 to January 2021, SSgt Sandlin was assigned to the 36<sup>th</sup> Logistics Readiness Squadron, Andersen AFB, Guam. SSgt Sandlin served as the NCOIC, Mobile Distribution, where he led 35 Airmen delivering fuel to aircraft throughout the base. He was then selected to fill a dual-hatted role, serving as the NCOIC for both Fuels Training and Fuels Support. In his Fuels Training role, SSgt Sandlin authored the unit's upgrade training program and enabled Airmen's successful completion of required skill-level training. In his Fuels Support role, SSgt Sandlin managed the unit's \$456,000 budget, ensuring 76 members were equipped for duties. (T)Sgt Sandlin then took on the role of NCOIC, Fuels Service Center, where he led 14 personnel responsible for ordering, storing, and distributing fuel to aircraft and base tenant units. In this role, (T)Sgt Sandlin supported three large scale exercises including COPE NORTH, VALIANT SHIELD, and PACIFIC IRON. During the COVID-19 pandemic, he established the fuel delivery system for an Expeditionary Medical Support System that supported over 5,000 Navy personnel.



In January 2021, TSgt Sandlin joined the 5<sup>th</sup> Logistics Readiness Squadron at Minot AFB, ND. TSgt Sandlin led the Fuels Environmental and Safety Office, managing the flight's safety programs and compliance with US environmental standards. He deployed to Al Dhafra Air Base, United Arab Emirates where he served as the NCOIC, Fuels Service Center, leading 45 personnel and managing a fleet of 21 vehicles at USCENTCOM's largest fuel depot. In this role, TSgt Sandlin supported multiple large-scale US combat operations, including SPARTAN SHIELD, FREEDOM SENTINEL, and INHERENT RESOLVE. Upon returning to Minot AFB, TSgt Sandlin's outstanding performance in a deployed environment led to his appointment as NCOIC, Fuels Service Center where he meticulously led a 6-member team in managing the wing's inventory, ordering, billing, forecasting and delivery of fuel to 23 units and organizations across the base, providing critical support to USSTRATCOM's nuclear deterrence operations.
